
Sermon Notes October 11th 2020



Ephesians 1:21-23 NLT

"Now he is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else—not only in this world but also in the world to come. God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made him head over all things for the benefit of the church. And the church is his body; it is made full and complete by Christ, who fills all things everywhere with himself."

When God created us He not only gave us **responsibility**. He also gave us **authority**.

Genesis 1:27-28.

27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Our position determines our outcome. We are always looking for a different outcome without changing our position!

How do we position ourselves?

1. Know who you are

Your effectiveness in the Kingdom of God is directly connected to your position with and in The King. Son and daughter!

This is the area the enemy attacks the most.

During that time the devil came and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become loaves of bread." But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say, 'People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." Then the devil took him to the holy city, Jerusalem, to the highest point of the Temple, and said, "If you are the Son of God, jump off! For the Scriptures say, 'He will order his angels to protect you. And they will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone." Jesus responded, "The Scriptures also say, 'You must not test the LORD your God." (Matthew 4:3-7 NLT)

The problem is identity theft. John 10:10

Numbers 13:26-33 - You cannot possess with a grasshopper identity.

Your position will change your condition or circumstance - 2 Chro. 20:17

If you don't take your place, the enemy will!

2. We position ourselves with covenant relationships (Love and Unity)

John 13:34, 35 NASB - A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

3. Position to conquer

Joshua 21:43-45 NKJV

So, the Lord gave to Israel all the land of which He had sworn to give to their fathers, and they took **possession** of it and dwelt in it. The Lord gave them rest all around, according to all that He had sworn to their fathers. And not a man of all their enemies stood against them; the Lord delivered all their enemies into their hand. Not a word failed of any good thing which the Lord had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.
