# When I embrace His truth, It will lead me to freedom & victory!

## John 8:31-32 (TPT)

31 Jesus said to those Jews who believed in him, "When you continue to embrace all that I teach, you prove that you are my true followers. 32 For if you embrace the truth, it will release more freedom into your lives."

## Where do I find truth?

## The word of God - Psalm 119:160

The entirety of Your word *is* **truth**, And every one of Your righteous judgments *endures* forever.

## The Father - Psalm 86:15

But You, O Lord, *are* a God full of compassion, and gracious, Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and **truth**.

## Jesus Christ - John 14:16

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the **truth**, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

## Holy Spirit - John 16:13

However, when He, the Spirit of **truth**, has come, He will guide you into all **truth**; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

## What is truth?

Truth is unchangeable

Truth is always true despite how one feels about it

Truth remains truth even if no one believes it's truth.

14 Put on truth as a belt to strengthen you to stand in triumph. Put on holiness as the protective armor that covers your heart.

# How do I live victoriously?

Recognize - Untruth (thinking, culture, circumstance, relationships)

Repent - Take responsibility

Renounce - Breaking the agreement

Reclaim - Take back the keys that belong to you! This is what Jesus did on the cross!
